GDPR

You have probably come across those initials - they stand for General Data Protection Regulation. It's a new law, replacing the Data Protection Act, governing the use of your personal data. You may have been asked to consent to the use of your data, such as your name and address, by other organisations.

To comply with GDPR we need to ask you to give your consent to Immanuel and St Andrew having and using your data - without which we may not be able to communicate with you or indeed do many of the things we do. Last week during the Service we asked everyone to complete a consent form, which has some boxes to tick, and we will repeat that today - for those who didn't do it last week.
